Tip before you start

See the **English / Español** buttons at the top of every page? Tap either one anytime — the whole page switches languages.

The flow

Follow the path top to bottom.

Open the site — then follow this:

1 Not sure where to start?

Tap Start Here (or the Signs check) to find your level

2 Learning a new topic?

Open your Unit → pick a lesson from the roadmap → watch the video (English or Español) → read the 4 steps

3 Ready to practice?

In the lesson: try “Your turn,” then do the 10-problem assessment on paper

4 Studying for a test?



5 Stuck on something?

Resources: calculator help, tricky look-alikes, reference sheet

Handy to know

- Flip to **Español** anytime with the language button.
- On flashcards, mark the ones you miss — they come back so you actually learn them.
- The calculator won't do the thinking, but it's great for checking your answer.
- Print anything that helps and keep it in your binder.
- On the Regents Trainer, try 'Blind' once 'Cue' feels easy.
